Our Uniform policy directly links to our Believe & Achieve seven core values; *Ambition, Character, Community, Excellence for all, Love of Learning, Outstanding Relationships and Pride.* We *pride* ourselves on being smart, well presented and ready for learning. It is our school policy that all students wear school uniform when attending school, or when participating in school organised events such as educational visits or sporting competitions unless parents are informed otherwise. When wearing the Paignton Academy uniform we are recognised in the *community* and with that comes a responsibility to be our best selves and portray our best *characters* all times.

We request continued support of parents/guardians with regards to uniform. The expectation is that students wear the correct Paignton Academy full uniform at all times (in school, and to and from school) as it reflects on the individual as well as the School community.

#### 1. Aims

### The policy aims to:

- How the uniform should be sourced and supplier arrangements
- Explain our approach to reduce the costs whilst still offering the best value for money and service for parents and guardians
- Ensure we do not discriminate those with protected characteristics as defined by the Equality Act 2010
- Clarify our expectations for school uniform and establish clearly what is a compulsorily item and what is optional
- Confirmation of sanctions and how to make a complaint regarding the uniform policy

# 3. Affordability whilst still providing good value for money and excellent service

Our school has a duty of care to make sure that the uniform we require is affordable, in line with statutory guidance from the Department for Education on the cost of school uniform.

We understand that items with distinctive characteristics (such as branded items, or items that have to have a school logo or a unique fabric / colour / design) cannot be purchased from a wide range of retailers and that requiring many such items limits parents' ability to 'shop around' for a low price.

We have carefully considered the expectations for uniform and have made the following adjustments:

	uniform, unless it is required (e.g. your child has outgrown their uniform
	or you need to replace an item).

Disputes about the cost of school uniform should be resolved via the Complaints Policy.

### 4. Our school's legal duties under the Equality Act 2010

The Equality Act 2010 prohibits discrimination against an individual based on the protected characteristics, which include sex, race, religion or belief, and gender reassignment.

To avoid discrimination, our school will:

- Avoid listing uniform items based on sex, to give all students the opportunity to wear the uniform they feel most comfortable in or that most reflects their self-identified gender.
- Make sure that our uniform costs the same for all students.
- Allow all students to have long hair (though we reserve the right to ask for this to be tied back).
- Allow all students to style their hair in the way that is appropriate for school yet makes them feel most comfortable. See section 6.0 'Presentation'.

- Allow students to wear headscarves and other religious or cultural symbols / jewellery
   please speak with the school to ensure that we are full informed of your expectations
- Allow for adaptations to our policy on the grounds of equality by asking students or their parents to get in touch with the Principal (in writing for parents), who can answer questions about the policy and respond to any requests.

- Footwear that does not comply with section 5 e.g trainers or coloured footwear

### 6. Presentation

Please note we cannot take responsibility for the security of any jewellery, mobile phones or tablets brought into the Academy.

In addition to the uniform these items are also permitted:

- Two small rings To be removed in PE and other practical lessons
- One small necklace To be removed in PE and other practical lessons
- Two plain stud or sleeper earrings per ear
- A small transparent nose stud will be permitted
- Make up should be discreet
- Hair colour should be natural with no shaved patterns or beads
- Clear nail varnish
- Waterproof coat

## Not permitted:

• Nose ring or metal stud / Tongue / Lip / or any other body/ facial piercings will not be

- permitted.
- No false eyelashes
- False nails, nails with enhancement (gels), natural nails of a length which presents a health and safety risk

## 8. Sanctions for non – compliance with Uniform Policy

- Pupils are required to bring a note if they are unable to meet the uniform expectations and then will be considered for a green card exception
- For minor breaches such as untucked shirt or not wearing blazer staff will use Class
   Charts to issue a Uniform fault\*
- For major breaches such as unnatural hair colour, white trainers, false nails, nails with enhancement (gels), natural nails of a length which presents a health and safety risk or refusing to remove piercings pupils will be isolated in the Reset Room until the breach is corrected. In some circumstances 24 hours may be given to rectify before a sanction is applied
- Ongoing breaches of our uniform policy will result in the <u>Rewards & Behaviour Policy</u> (see sections 14) being applied and on occasions the child will be given the correct uniform and expected to change into what is supplied. Fixed Term Suspension could be used for persistently failing to following instructions
- In cases where it is suspected that financial hardship has resulted in a student not complying with this uniform policy, staff will take a mindful and considerate approach to resolving the situation.

\* x3 or more uniform faults in a week will result in a 30 minute after school detention.

## 9. Pre-Loved Uniform - Paignton Academy Swap Shop

We are always looking at ways we can help and support our students and their families as well as our local community and we able to facilitate a free uniform swap shop.

- Open every Tuesday (during term time) from 3–4pm, located at the Waterleat Road Centre.
- This service is available to ALL students and parents/guardians.

### How it works:

- Bring uniform you have grown out of and swap for a bigger size (depending on the stock we have; however, we will try our best to accommodate if we can).
- We will accept: Academy Blazers, Ties, Skirts, PE Items and Shirts, Trousers, Black Shoes and Coats .
- We will also welcome donations of uniform no longer needed, the item/s can be dropped off during school hours via the Reception Offices on either site and will be added to our Swap Shop stock.
- Pupils are informed of this service every Monday morning during the Culture and Values tutor time session.
- We advertise this service regularly via our social media page.
