Parents can collect or take their children from the away games (i.e Churston) for a match if they so wish, please just let the teacher know at the time.

Rugby in schools is only played in the Autumn term and in December it usually gets too dark for longer away games and sometimes pitches can become flooded, so we want to maximise October and November.
